- Measure:
 - Arrival and departure time along with specified intervals during the visit will be measured and analyzed.
- QI Processes:
 - The QI Team has already completed a Process Map and they are working on a Root Cause Analysis



Time Data



Type of Visit	Duration
Problem	~20 min
Quickstart	~33 min
Initial	~28 min
Annual	~35 min
Birth Control	~26 min

Average visit time ~ 38 min



Missing Data



- 32 out of 49 teen patients had missing data.
- To correct this problem, the QI Team has implemented these data collection points:
 - Type of visit
 - Reception Time-in
 - Records Time-in
 - Reception to Records Time
 - Lab

- Teen Clinic-in
- Lab to teen clinic time
- Teen Clinic-out
- Teen Clinic total time

 - To improve and increase access to HIV testing and counseling.
- Measure:
 - Monitoring HIV testing rates.
- QI Processes:
 - Brainstorming.



Southeast Health District

- Objective:
 - To problem solve HIV Wellness Center data entry and documentation procedures.
- Measure:
 - Systematically monitor Careware data entry.
- QI Processes:
 - The QI Team is currently Process Mapping.
